

## F. I. B. E. Committees

1. Books-This entails writing to publishers and asking for donations of books and building up a John Dewey H.S. Women's library in any way possible, short of theft(unless you can do it without getting caught).
2. Materials-This group will write away to government agencies, feminist groups, organizations, etc. to get pamphlets, magazines, films, etc. for the Women's Studies Institute and club.
3. Newsletter-The newsletter will contain articles about current issues involving women in the world and in school, poetry, stories, interviews, surveys, editorials, announcements of feminist events such as rallies, shows, films, art exhibits, etc. AND any other creative ideas that come up along the way.
4. Speakers-You will write or call many fascinating people from all different fields and walks of life to get them to speak at Dewey. Only those who are extremely optimistic and persevering should sign up for this group.
5. Advisory Board-We are trying to get famous people to lend their names to the Advisory Board of the Institute purely for prestige purposes. You would have to try to contact these people to invite them and also be able to explain what the Institute is all about. We would like to contact members of the community, politicians, writers, feminists, professors, etc.
6. Bulletin Board-The board will be about the club, the Institute and also about the accomplishments of women-past and present.
7. Publicity-This committee will devise methods of getting the media interested in what we're doing and contacting papers, magazines, t.v. shows, etc. (We already have some hints on how to do this).
8. Country Fair-This committee will organize whatever activity we decide to sponsor for Country Fair. Some ideas were: Challenge of the Sexes, selling feminist T-shirts and books and crafts.
9. Statistics-We would like to publish in the newsletter such statistics as: the % of girls in auto shop, the #of boys in Dance, the % of women chairpersons, etc. The committee would be responsible for gathering these figures and keeping tabs on them to see if the formation of the club and Institute has any effect.
