(All checks should be made out to FRIENDS OF DEWEY and must reach us by September 29th -- after that any remaining tickets will be sold to any interested Deweyites.) Your tickets will be mailed to you.

For December, Friends of Dewey is planning a trip to the Sky Rink, ice-skating rink in Manhattan on Wednesday, December 28th. If you are interested, send us your name and address (on the reverse side of this page). DO NOT SEND MONEY. We will contact you later. However, you will save 50¢ from the admission price of \$3.50 and we are looking into a discount on the \$1.50 price of the skates. But you must contact us now.
