**THREE MEMBER COUNCIL**  
The three-member council serves to administer all affairs of the Student Organization, represent the whole student body, lead any action regarding the student body, and to coordinate and oversee all S.O. committees. The three members of this council share equal power.

**CONSULTATIVE COUNCIL**  
Consultative Council representatives, along with one three-man council representative act as policy consultants to the principal. The Consultative Council consists of five students, five parents, five teachers and the principal.

**STUDENT ORGANIZATION TREASURER**  
Under the supervision of the S.O., the treasurer will be in charge of all monies and will preside over the allocation of funds to clubs, groups etc.

**BROOKLYN BOROUGH STUDENT COUNCIL**  
Two members will be elected to represent John Dewey H.S. at monthly meetings of the Brooklyn Borough Student Council which is attended by representatives from all of Brooklyn's High Schools.

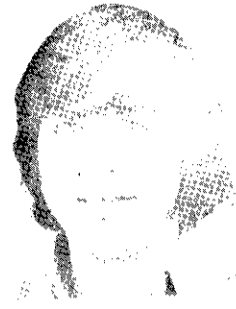

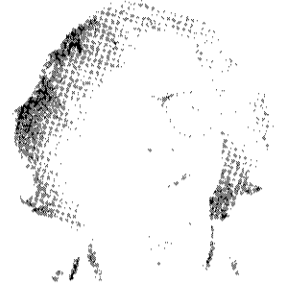
## Mitchell Gilbert
