

Three-year Sequence in Data Processing, Keypunch and Computer Programming.

- A. The student is required to take the following 2 phases:
 Introduction to Data Processing-(755)
 Elementary IBM Keypunch Operation-(756)*
 AND A
- B. Minimum of eight (8) cycles from the courses listed below:
 Advanced Keypunch-(757)*
 RPG Programming-Phases 1-5 (758-763)**
 Cobol Programming-Phases 1-2 (764-765)*
 Cobol Programming-Phases 3-5 (7651-7652-7653)*
- * Course immediately preceding is a prerequisite.
 ** Students who have Computer Mathematics, or one year of Accounting may go directly into (758) OR (764).
- C. The remaining five (5) cycles, necessary to complete the three-year (15 cycle) sequence, may be selected from the following:
