

Dear Mr. Levine:

In connection with your letter of inquiry of September 16, 1970 concerning the status of the paved, fenced lot in question, subsequent examination of the damage map for the taking of lands for the new high school revealed that subject lot is not within the official site of the school. The Parks Department also indicated said lot was not assigned to them. There is also a claim by a private party that the land in question belongs to him and was never legally taken.

From the foregoing, it would appear that until the legal status of the lot is settled nothing can be done. Furthermore you should know that it is the contention of the Budget Director's Office that no funds are to be expended in the further acquisition of lands purely for teacher's parking purposes. Please be guided by the above mentioned considerations.
